Workshop attendance is free of charge. Lunch and refreshments will be provided. Participants are also invited to join the workshop dinner in the evening of September 13. Travel or accommodation costs are not covered.

The 2018 Doctoral Workshop is coordinated with the *1st Conference of the Swiss Society of Health Economics*, which will take place on September 14, 2018 at the University of Lucerne. Workshop participants are encouraged to attend both events. Rejected papers for the workshop may be transferred to the conference.
