Your tasks:

You will make important contributions to the development and coordination of the HEF; plan, conduct and publish research projects in health economic evaluation, health services research and related fields; provide advice to clinical colleagues and contribute to the acquisition of third party funding. Involvement in academic teaching is expected.

Your profile:

- You hold a doctoral degree in health economics, epidemiology or another relevant discipline
- You have excellent knowledge and hands-on experience in applied health economics or health economic evaluation. Skills in cost-effectiveness analysis alongside randomised/prospective clinical studies and/or in the analysis of large, real-world datasets, applying causal inference techniques, are of particular interest,
- A proven ability to publish in reputable, international journals with peer-review,
- Appropriate working knowledge of the following fields: economics, health technology assessment, epidemiological methods, biostatistics, medicine,
- Organizational talent, appropriate communication skills, ability to work independently and in a group, willingness to meet timelines, responsibility and enthusiasm,
- Excellent mastery of English. At least good working knowledge of German is an asset.
